Would you like to use your time and talents where they are needed, and in return enjoy fellowship and the fulfillment of a job well done?

Who are we and what are we talking about?

We are the Christian men and women of the Northwest IL Area Cursillo and Quad City Emmaus Community. Having experienced the grace of God ourselves, we recognize our mission to bring others to experience God's love and grace.

Inspired by the Cursillo (pronounced Cur-see-o) philosophy of Christian Community in Action (or CCIA), the Believers Together Reunion Home Project, Inc. was born.

The Mission:
Create "Christ's Equity" in a single-family housing project.

We are hoping this is the first home of many. Our first home is located in Aledo, IL (corner of SE 10th and SE 11th Avenues) in the Hidden Valley Development area.

A quality home, controlled by qualified trades people, and valued at approximately \$190,000, will be built and sold (hopefully by 12/31/03).

Net proceeds of this home will be donated to Northwest IL Area Cursillo (40%), Quad City Emmaus Community (20%), and the Mercer County Family YMCA (40%); the county where the home is located.

What can YOU do?

We need your time, talent, materials, monetary donations, friends, prayers; whatever **you** want to do.

Here are some examples of how you can help create "Christ's Equity" in the Aledo home.

† Gifting

You may want to donate something from your inventory, purchase it in tandem with your supplier or vendor, or contribute your time or your skilled workforce.

You may also consider eliminating the cost of carrying a particular item in your stock, and claim the fair market value of your contribution as a **tax deductible expense**.

† Deep Discounting

You may choose to create "Christ's Equity" by completing a function at a discount. For example, labor for coordinating drywall installation; labor is provided at \$400 rather than the market price of \$1200.

What other opportunities are there?

† Skilled and Unskilled Labor Contributions

The quality of the house will be controlled by qualified trades people. However, unskilled labor will be needed in each phase of the project.

Each contractor will identify what tasks can be done with unskilled labor, providing an opportunity for anyone to participate in the project.

† Contribution of Professional Services

Every construction project incurs professional and agency expenses (e.g., appraisers, insurance, legal expenses, engineering). If you are one of these professionals, you can contribute your services, or as an agency, you might recognize this project as a **fundraiser to a non-profit corporation**.
